FINEST RAW MATERIALS.

From pellets to the finished window and on to recycling: We see environmental protection and sustainability as an integral part of our daily operations – and this starts at the very beginning by using only the finest raw materials.

True to our 'greenline' maxim, we stopped using lead-based stabilisers in our PVC-U profiles almost two decades ago, switching instead to an eco-friendly calcium/zinc basis. This prevents the mining and use of 6500 tonnes of lead every year – that's more than 160 lorries full.



SUSTAINABLE PRODUCTION.

We think about the entire life cycle of a window and aim to act in an environmentally friendly manner every step of the way.

That's why we place such importance on ensuring the production of our profiles is sustainable and energy-efficient.

Our engineers are developing the newest generations of products to use less material, while also improving technical properties. Intelligent chamber systems and static design features not only ensure resources are preserved, but also result in highly competitive products.

We feel a strong sense of commitment to Germany. That's why our window systems for the domestic market are produced exclusively in our German plants, thereby keeping the jobs in the country.



We are making advances in tackling plastic pollution in the oceans and advocate for sustainable solutions. We were the first company in the windows sector to receive the "Zero Pellet Loss" certification.



OUR PROMISE:

- To stabilise the PVC-U without the use of lead, using instead an environmentally friendly calcium/zinc basis.
- To use recycled material. Maintaining a closed-loop material cycle without compromising on quality.
- High thermal insulation window systems that lower heating costs and reduce CO₂ emissions.





Windows play a pivotal role in any passive house. Our ultra-modern systems meet the requirements of a passive house, sometimes even in the standard design.



ENERGY EFFICIENCY IN MODERN WINDOWS.

KÖMMERLING Premium windows are high-tech products, which meet the highest specifications for thermal insulation and the associated energy efficiency ratings.



In numerical terms: The roughly 15 million window units that are produced from our profiles every year save around 300 million litres of fuel oil. This prevents some 850 million kilograms of CO₂ from entering the atmosphere – which, in turns, relieves the burden on woodland equivalent in area to 90,000 football pitches.

By fitting KÖMMERLING's modern Premium windows, significantly less heating energy is required, thereby reducing the emission of harmful greenhouse gases. Valuable resources are saved for the next generation.

As a founding member of Germany's national recycling initiative Rewindo, we guarantee old PVC-U windows are recycled in a closed-loop cycle.

A COMMITTED APPROACH TO RECYCLING.

A PVC-U window has a theoretical service life of 50 years and can be recycled at least seven times.

By recycling old windows, we put them back into the material cycle and purposefully use a proportion of recycled materials in our profiles. This involves processing the PVC-U profiles of old windows into pellets and using the reclaimed material together with aesthetically superior virgin material to produce new windows.


This demonstrates how we can use our market-specific expertise to make resource-efficient products that reflect our responsible approach: For every kilogram of recycled PVC we use, two kilograms of CO₂ is saved.

Under our ReFrame brand, we are producing our first window profiles from 100% recycled PVC-U material, and the resulting quality is exceptional. To give them their UV resistance and their premium look, these profiles are treated with the innovative proCoverTec colour finish.



OUR RECYCLING SERVICE

With our own additional recycling programme, we ensure that materials can be reused specifically for our profiles.



Recycled materials accrued during window production and old PVC-U windows are collected and returned to us.

We recondition the PVC-U recycled materials and old PVC-U windows and use them to produce new windows.

We supply PVC-U profiles made from high-quality and controlled recycled material.



Our company finds many ways to contribute to different areas of society: From donating to and funding social projects to installing solar panels on our company roofs.
